I want you to know that I am thoroughly pleased with the fuel injection system that I recently purchased from Radial Engines, Ltd., and with the installation of that system on the Jacobs R755A2 engine on my Cessna 195. Aubie Pearman, Clay, Tripp, and the rest of the crew at Tupelo Aero in Tupelo, Mississippi did a great job on the installation, with some assistance from Bill Milton of The 195 Factory.


I personally observed virtually the entire installation process. The Bendix fuel injection servo was a relatively easy replacement for the carburetor and required no modification to the engine or the airbox/lower cowl. Replacement of existing intake tubes with new tubes with GAMI injectors also greatly simplified the process. The installation of the auxiliary fuel pump was quick and effortless.

The enhanced engine performance and fuel economy as a result of the fuel injection is quite notable. The equalized fuel distribution has boosted take off and climb performance, and has allowed me to use higher power settings with lower fuel consumption. Take off distance and rate of climb are noticeably improved. Likewise, I have achieved higher cruise speeds and lower fuel consumption at the same power settings I used before installation of the fuel injection system.

I am really enjoying the improved performance of my Cessna 195 after installation of the fuel injection system. While fuel economy was not my primary motivation in deciding to install fuel injection, at \$4.00 per gallon for fuel, burning a few less gallons per hour is certainly a bonus.

Thanks for all the hard work the two of you, and others like John Collette, Aubie Pearman, and Bill Milton, put into obtaining the STC for this system, as well as the improvement of our venerable old flying jalopies.
